1. CALL TO ORDER

The Chair called the meeting to order at 6:02pm and welcomed two new City appointees, Kevin Evans and James Fox. Thanks were expressed to Don Evans, Terry Hood and Sheryl Fisher for work done on recent initiatives. The agenda was approved unanimously on a motion by Mr. Hood, seconded by Ms Downes.

2. ELECTION OF CHAIR FOR 2016

Ms Kirkpatrick called for nominations for the position of Commission Chair. Don Evans nominated Sanford Osler. Mr. Osler accepted the nomination. There being no other nominees for the position of Chair, Sanford Osler was acclaimed Chair of the Commission for 2016.

The Chair called for nominations for the position of Vice-Chair. Councillor Bell nominated Don Evans. Mr. Evans accepted the nomination. There being no other nominees for the position of Vice-Chair, Don Evans was acclaimed Vice-Chair of the Commission for 2016.

3. APPOINTMENT OF GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The Chair noted that the Governance Committee is the sole Standing Committee of the Commission. It meets four or five times per year, has a broad mandate, and is required to bring its recommendations for approval by the Commission. Appointees have traditionally been the Commission Chair, Vice-Chair and the two municipal council

representatives; he was recommending that this continue. The Chair MOVED and Kevin Evans SECONDED

THAT appointees to the Governance Committee for 2016 are the Commission Chair, the Vice-Chair, and the Council representatives from the City and the District of North Vancouver.

New Museum

Aboriginal Voices Partnership Update

Mr. Hood noted that a follow-up presentation meeting with the Squamish Nation Chief Ian Campbell and Council had been held on January 20th, with himself, Ms Kirkpatrick, Mr. Osler, Ms Fisher and the new curator, Karen Dearlove, in attendance. Many ideas for potential projects were explored and support was given to the new museum Aboriginal Voices partnership. Formal support letters for the New Museum project have been received from the Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh Nations, and from the Aboriginal Tourism Association of BC.

7. REPORTS

Director's Report

Ms Kirkpatrick noted the following:

New curator Karen Dearlove started work on January 18th and will be introduced at the February Commission meeting.

- The *Water's Edge* exhibit is expected to be substantially completed by the end of February.
- She had been invited to be part of the District's 125th Anniversary Team. Dan Francis' book is ahead of deadline.
- Young Canada Works student employment grant applications have been submitted; one is for two theatrical interpreters and the other is for a web technician for the Archives.

Governance Committee

The Chair noted that a committee meeting will be held prior to the next Commission meeting.

Friends Society

Mr. Gilmour noted the following:
