THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF NORTH VANCOUVER

BYLAW 7428

A bylaw to prohibit the sounding of locomotive whistles at the Philip Avenue BC Rail Line Crossing.

The Council for The Corporation of the District of North Vancouver, having observed the relevant provisions of the Railway Act of British Columbia (Chapter 395), enacts the following:

Title

1. This bylaw may be cited as "**Philip Avenue Train Whistle Prohibition Bylaw**".
2. The sounding of any engine bell or whistle in accordance with the provisions of Section 175 of the Railway Act of British Columbia (Chapter 395) at the BC Rail Line crossing at Philip Avenue (BCR Mileage 1.6) in the District of North Vancouver is hereby prohibited.
