

Youth-Friendly North Shore Youth Action Grants

Application Guidelines

We're thrilled that you're interested in applying for funding to bring your vision to life. Below, you'll find all the details you need to submit a successful application.

Before you apply, make sure you go through the guidelines checklist.

Who can apply?

To qualify for funding, your project must meet the following criteria:

- Led by a group of at least three youth aged 12-20 residing or attending school on the North Shore
- Supported by a responsible adult mentor from the community
- Aligned with the objectives of the YFNS program, focusing on youth well-being, community safety, and engagement

What should my project accomplish?

Your project should address one or more of the following areas:

- Enhancing safety for youth in public and digital spaces
- Creating or enhancing spaces and programs tailored for youth
- Strengthening community connections
- Providing opportunities for youth civic engagement

Eligible expenses

Grant funds can be used to pay for:

- Professional and consultant costs
- Travel
- Office equipment or supplies



- Minor renovations to program facility
- Translation or interpretation costs
- Meals and/or refreshments
- Honoraria
- Training costs

Note: projects with an organizational affiliation can include a 10% project administration fee to support project activities

Grant funds cannot be used to pay for:

- Regular or ongoing police services
- Core or ongoing operating expenses (including rent, utilities or salaries of existing employees)
- Hospitality, that does not meet the eligible expenses criteria
- Interest charges or costs of borrowing; and
- Amortization
- Alcohol, nicotine or cannabis products

How much money can I get?

Individual projects may receive funding ranging from \$100 to \$3,000, inclusive of applicable taxes

- Youth groups not associated with an organization can apply for \$100 \$500.
- Youth groups associated with an organization can apply for \$100 \$3000.

Funding will be provided based on project needs, with consideration for expenses such as supplies, honoraria, and travel

How do I apply?

- Complete the online application with detailed information about your project.
- Provide a comprehensive project plan, including objectives, activities, and a budget breakdown
- Submit all required documentation (application form and budget form) by the specified deadline for review

How do you decide which applications to accept?

 Applications will be reviewed based on alignment with grant criteria, feasibility, and potential impact



• Applicants will receive a Notice of Decision within three weeks of submitting their application
